Concepts in Health Care

You're job in managng stress is to lern these things:

- Your personnel stressors.
- Amount of stress you can take before it becomes a problem.
- Stress management strategies that work for you.

Heimlich Maneuver

Most dogs will chew anything: bones, toys, shoes, socks, etc. If the dog is suffocating, it will often panic. A dog may paw at its mouth if something is lodged. If there is a partial airway, attempt oxygen therapy and have the animal transported to veterinary care as soon as possible.

Immediate Care:
Be very careful, even calm animals may panic when they cannot breathe, you may need to restrain the dog, but do not MUZZLE it.

1. Use both hands to open the mouth, with one hand on the upper jaw and other on the lower.
2. Look inside the mouth and remove the obstruction with your fingers or perhaps a "flat spoon handle" (or something similar) to pry object away from the teeth or roof of the mouth and remove it.

Heimlich Maneuver

1. Lie the dog on its side, place one hand on the back for support and use the other hand to exert pressure on the abdomen upwards and forwards.
2. Check the dog's mouth and remove any objects that may become dislodged. You may need to repeat #1 several times.
