**IRTB (Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings)**

Course Description: this course is designed to prepare emergency responders to perform effectively and safely during bombing incidents, principally in support roles within the warm and cold zones of the incident scene. The course includes the familiarization with improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and explosive materials and detailed training on critical response actions during pre – and post-detonation operations. In addition, the course addresses actions that emergency responders can take to prevent and/or deter bombing attacks against their communities

**PSRBI (Prevention of and Response to Suicide Incidents)**

This course provides training on the suicide bombing threat. The course includes familiarization with improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and explosive materials typically used in suicide bombings. It also addresses actions that individual emergency responders can take to assist in preventing or deterring suicide bombings, as well as techniques, tactics, and procedures that support an effective and safe response to a suicide bombing.
